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### Terms and Conditions

The University has developed the International Athlete Bursary to ensure students who qualify to study at SGS Sport Bristol and perform at the highest level of sport are actively supported. The programme is seen as a partnership between the elite athlete and the SGS Sport .

### Application & Panel

1. Membership of the Programme is for a one-year period only. All applicants are required to re [apply](#) each academic year.
2. Membership on the Programme is decided by the International Athlete Bursary Panel against set criteria.
3. Having applied to the scheme using an application form, new applicants will be contacted by the Head of Sport to discuss their application. Existing members can re-apply over the summer period.
4. Places on the scheme are granted and renewed by the International Athlete Bursary. This committee has a broad spectrum of representation on it, from different sections of the College community. The decision of the Panel on all applications is final.

### Conditions to be fulfilled by the athlete

1. Members will be expected to contribute to the relevant academies and academic course and will be expected to represent the College in relevant sporting competitions and at other events.
2. Members will be asked to act as a representative of the College, maintain or improve their sporting performance and satisfy the College with their academic progress.
3. Members will be required to produce an annual report giving details of their sporting achievements over the past year. This report should contain details of how any financial award was used. This report shall be taken into account when renewal of the bursary is under consideration.
4. Members shall provide help in promoting the sporting profile of the College in any way seen fit by the College. Members are asked to submit publicity photographs upon joining the scheme and to supply more as appropriate throughout the year.
5. Members will be expected to attend the Sports Awards and other promotional events held by the wider Academy. This may be waived by the Head of Sport.
6. Any other duties as in accordance with the above, as requested with the Head of Sport.
6. Failure in any of these areas, without good cause, will result in termination of the Bursary.

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
