What is sexual harassment?

Sexual harassment is unwanted behaviour of a sexual nature which violates your dignity, makes you feel intimidated, degraded or humiliated creates a hostile or offensive environment.

Sexual harassment can include, sexual comments or jokes, physical behaviour, including unwelcome sexual advances, touching and various forms of sexual assault. It includes displaying pictures, photos or drawings of a sexual nature and / or sending emails / messages with a sexual content. It can be a one-off incident or a persistent pattern of behaviour and can occur anywhere.
